1. CODE OF CONDUCT

2. EXPECTED MINIMUM STANDARD OF BEHAVIOUR OF EVERY JUVENILE/JUNIOR MEMBER

- 4. Juvenile/Junior Members must report accidents or any other incidents to the Coach without delay so the Coach can take appropriate action.
- 5. Parents/Guardians and Coaches will encourage Juvenile/Junior Members to develop their abilities responsibly. This includes developing an awareness of winning and losing as outcomes outside our direct control. We actively promote the attitude that success means performing to the best of our abilities.
- 6. Receiving and giving constructive feedback are central part of the learning experience on and off the course.
